1. Introduction

This manual describes the operation guidelines for the 1RU EDFA. The safety and operating instructions must be carefully read to ensure the product be well installed and operated.

1.1 Production Description

The 1RU EDFA comprises one EDFA module, packaged within a rack mountable 1RU unit. This unit can be operated as a fully independent network element using a comprehensive and user-friendly RS232 communications, and is an excellent solution for immediate deployment of EDFA-based systems. The EDFA module in 1RU unit is low noise C-band WDM optical amplifier is designed to amplify multi-channel optical signals to increase the optical transmission distance over fiber.

1.2 Configuration description




Fig.3 The back and sides Panels of 1RU EDFA

3.2 Installation

1. Place the unit into a 19-inch wide rack or cabinet. Make sure leaving sufficient

space above or below the unit for airflow heat-transfer purpose.

2. 1RU EDFA is designed to work between - °C 5~ °C 55 °C (°F 23~1 °F 31 °F) temperature range.

Humidity should not exceed 95%. Installation is recommended in a temperature & humidity controlled, dust-free environment.

3. The equipment is designed to be powered by steady voltage AC 48V. Request of power supply:

AC input Power	48V
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4. The machine must have good grounding with grounding resistance $<4\Omega$. Before connecting circuit, use #20AWG and higher electric wire to connect the grounding screw on the bottom and the grounding frame. When using DC input power supply the equipment chassis must be grounding.

3.3 Operation

- 1. Plug in the AC 48V redundant Power Supplies.
- 2. Connect optical cables to the optical In/Out connectors.

Note: Before connect the In/Out optical cables, it is recommended to clean fiber-optic connectors. It can help prevent interconnect problems and therefore aid system performance. When optical connectors are disconnected and reconnected, the fiber surface can become dirty or scratched. The goal of cleaning the fiber optic connectors is to remove all dust and contaminants without leaving any residue. When the optical connectors are disconnected, mate the connector with an adapter or cover with an end cap.

3. Turn on power switch in the back panel, the power indicators in the front panel is lighted.

Note: It is recommended to make all connections with the optical power off. This will reduce the risk of damage to the fiber.

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4. Input optical signal power, then press laser start-up key switch Laser status lamp turns green from Red.

Note: Observe laser safety precautions. Refer to Laser Safety earlier in this guide.


5. Turn on power switch in the back panel, the power indicators in the front panel is lighted.

3.4 Software Operating Instructions


- 1. The product supports RS232 serial communication, and the working status and related parameters of the product can be monitored and set in real time through upper computer software.
- 2. The software is stored in the attached CD, copy the "PC software" on the CD to the desktop of the computer.




- 3. Double-click the PC software to open the host computer interface and select the right serial port:
- (1) If you click "Open", you can directly read the module information through the serial port, as shown below:








(2) Click "Net Param Set" to set the network address of the rack, as shown below:




a. When the serial cable is connected, the current network address of the rack can be obtained. Do not change the MAC address. Other addresses can be set according to the network environment. After the network is set up successfully, the rack needs to be powered off and restarted. See figure below:







b. Close the communication settings, select SNMP in the Port Type drop-down menu; write the network address set in the previous step in Remote IP, and click "Open" to check the module information through the network port, as shown in the figure:



4. Working mode settings:

The product can work in APC or AGC mode, and the APC mode adjusts the output power of the EDFA module by setting the APC.

Select APC as "Working Mode", set the required output power, click "Setting", and "APC Parameters set success!" prompted, click "OK". Click "Read" to read the working information of the module. The AGC mode adjusts the output gain of the EDFA module by setting the AGC with same process.



3.6 Warning and Alarms

3.6.1 Alarm status

When the pump laser is in alarm, the status LED will turn red and be displayed the alarm status on the front panel. The alarm will not stop the EDFA but indicates the parameter is out of range. If the alarm stops, the parameter is within range.

When the Pump& Run LED is green, the device is working properly and the laser is on.

1RU EDFA monitors system operation and adjusts to the majority of power fluctuations. The PUMP laser will continue to work when in alarm. The alarm will disappear if the system parameter recovers into normal range. Some serious alarms can be eliminated by restarting the unit's power supply.

Most alarms are sent when the parameter is close to or exceeds the permitted range. In most situations the user cannot modify this status. Status modification needs special equipment and can only be modified in the factory.

In the case of an alarm, the unit's microprocessor will shut off the laser automatically.

3.7 Operation Notice

- Use only Single Mode Fiber (SMF) optic cable (9/125μM). Multi Mode Fiber (MMF) is incompatible with the equipment and will result in unacceptable performance and possible damage to the equipment.
- In order to ensure return loss is maximum, use only LC/UPC connectors. Clean and inspect connectors and fiber end faces prior to installation, and every plug in/out cycle.
- Use only industry approved methods, materials, and solutions for cleaning.
- Do not turn on the EDFA alone or without a protector cover at the unit connector end, otherwise the laser can do harm, especially to eyes. This is especially critical because the laser is invisible.
- Always turn off the laser prior to making connections to the EDFA. Failure to do

so may cause irreparable damage to the laser and EDFA.
